

**The following is the announcement made by Randy Larson during both worship celebrations on August 5, 2018.**

"Some of you have recently been asking for an update on our building project. Many of you will remember the prayer time we shared together on the plaza following both worship celebrations on Sunday July 1. Our hope and expectation that day was that we would be breaking ground soon thereafter and begin to do some of the prep work, such as site preparation, tree removal, and demolition of our existing Student Ministry Center! We have since been advised by the County Planning Department that an additional public review, required by the State, will occur over the next 45 days. We anticipate that it will take another 15 days or so after the completion of this process to secure approvals from the State and the County. We have been informed that a building permit will not be issued until all eight State and County agencies have given their approval, which we have been told and are fully confident, will be forthcoming.

As further news is available we will, of course, be sharing it with you.

Please join me and all of our elders in praying that this will go well for us, and that God's will and perfect timing for every phase of this exciting project will be accomplished for His glory.
