At Home

 *Set a rhythm!* These are some activities your family can do repeatedly and consistently over the summer while at home.


TIME IN THE WORD Make God's Word a priority in your home! Set a time and place for each person to consistently spend time in the Word. Additionally, make a plan to spend time in God's Word as a family. Consider reviewing the previous Sunday's passage and don't forget to pray together!

OPEN YOUR HOME Care for others! Invite friends, neighbors, your Sunday School teacher or Small Group Leader, and church family over for dinner, dessert or game nights. Take time to pray for them and your time together before they arrive.

SERVE AS A FAMILY It can actually be fun to serve! Find ways as a family to serve each other, your neighbors and your community.

SUMMER MEMORY JAR Remember and thank God for what He has done! As your family sees God's graces in your family's life, take time to jot it down on a piece of paper and place it in a jar in a central location in your home. At the end of the summer, read through all your memories and praise God for His goodness in your family's life, through the sweet moments and the struggle.

Out & About

 *Set a rhythm!* These are some activities your family can do repeatedly and consistently over the summer while out and about.

MEDITATE ON THE WORD Help God's Word to take root in your heart! Find creative ways to memorize God's Word AND apply it to your everyday circumstances while remembering Christ's sacrifice for us.

CONSIDER GOD'S HANDIWORK As you interact with other people, look for ways that God has graced their lives and share that with them! Also, as you see a magnificent mountaintop or look at colorful fish in the ocean, praise God for His gifts of creation!

PRAY AS A FAMILY Care for others! You may not know the person in line next to you at the movie theater or those who live in the town you are traveling through but you can pray for them! Pray that they might know the Hope of Christ and that God would place His people around them to be His hands and feet.
